The Community Builder needs to ideally live or work in Bridgwater who is directly connected to and linked into the various communities in the town and who is passionate about climate change and adaptation. Initially the Community Builder will be recruited to help shape the research and development stage of our project.

Overall Purpose: Working alongside delivery partners, Seed Sedgemoor and Stacked Wonky, to act as a catalyst through building relationships that enable people to engage in the project and act together for the common good creating more resilient communities.

Role will involve:
